National codes extract type	All
<b>Permitted Options (Custom Configuration)</b>	
30 - First Treatment	Treatment prescribed or procedure undertaken. Stop RTT clock
34 - Decision not to treat	Treatment not necessary eg consultation only. Stop RTT
20 - Subsequent activity during a referral to treatment period	Patient to be seen again for procedure
21 - Transfer to another Health Care Provider	Referral to QVH - Transfers RTT
31 - Start of active monitoring initiated by Patient	Stop RTT - Patient to request further OPD
32 - Start of active monitoring initiated by Care Professional	Stop RTT - Clinician request open
33 - Failure to attend	DNA appointment. Stops RTT.
11 - Active monitoring end	
90 - After treatment	
91 - Active Monitoring	Restarts clock if new OPD booked
12 - Consultant referral	
92 - Not yet referred	
35 - Patient declined offered treatment	Stop RTT
36 - Patient died before treatment	
10 - First activity	Opens RTT pathway - when patient booked on system

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### **34 (Stops RTT) – DECISION NOT TO TREAT**

Patient seen for a consultation but not requiring any prescribed treatment or intervention of any kind. Patient may have a follow-up but interventional treatment not considered relevant.

### **30 (Stops RTT) – FIRST TREATMENT PRESCRIBED OR SURGICAL BIOPSY OR EXCISION**

This can include patients who have been prescribed or had a treatment recommended to their GP even if a further follow-up is arranged. It may also include a diagnostic curative biopsy if this is considered as a potential curative treatment of the lesion.

### **31/32 (Stops RTT) – START OF ACTIVE MONITORING BY THE PATIENT OR CLINICIAN**

This is used when the patient requests an open appointment or it is recommended by the clinician.

### **20 (Keeps RTT Clock Running) – FURTHER INVESTIGATION, PROCEDURE OR OPD TREATMENT**

To be used when there is a decision to follow-up the patient for investigation, skin surgery for an excision, or a planned treatment when no prescribed medicine is administered. It keeps the RTT clock running so should only be used if there is a booked procedure or a definitive treatment date or date for investigation.

### **21 (Transfer RTT Clock) – TRANSFER TO ANOTHER HEALTHCARE PROVIDER**

Only used for specialist referrals to QVH for daycase surgery. Consider other reasons to stop the RTT clock if any prescribed medicine, investigation, or treatment initiated in-house in the department.
